Sustainable sourcing The GCP developed the Baseline Coffee Code, which contains principles of both good and bad agricultural and management practices, as well as international Globalization of supply chains and pressure to lower production costs have negatively impacted environments and communities around the world, especially in developing nations where production of high demand goods is increasingly taking place.
