Songwriter Eric Earley explains, "I get bored. I like to move things in a new direction ... I'm always writing, and if you're always writing things are going to change. You're going to try things out. And that's going to make its way into the music." Earley cites his influences on the album as

diverse as John Cale, Townes Van Zant, the Wu-Tang Clan and Waylon Jennings. "Townes probably is the biggest influence on the lyrics. His lyrics can be pretty strange. You don't know what he's talking about sometimes. I like that," Earley stated.
