Career counseling is closely related to, but not identical with, career guidance, vocational guidance, career coaching, employment

counseling, and career education. The boundaries between these terms vary across countries, languages, institutions, and professional traditions. In general usage, career guidance is often used as a broad umbrella term for information, education, assessment, advice, and systems-level support, whereas career counseling more often refers to a counselling-based intervention conducted individually or in small groups. In practice, the terms are frequently combined as career guidance and counselling to reflect the overlap between the activities. 051129cb56 The Society for Counseling Psychology in the United States states: Counseling Psychology is a generalist health service (HSP) specialty in professional psychology that uses a broad range of culturally informed and culturally sensitive practices to help people improve their well-being, prevent and alleviate distress and maladjustment, resolve crises, and increase their ability to function better in their lives. It focuses specifically but not exclusively on normative life-span development, with a particular emphasis on prevention and education as well as amelioration, addressing individuals as well... 051129cb56 School counselors are

Early texts and approaches associated with narrative career counselling include Larry Cochran's Career Counseling: A Narrative Narrative career counselling is an approach to career counselling that uses stories and narratives as central means through which people make sense of work, learning, identity, transitions, and future possibilities. It is commonly associated with constructivist, social constructionist, and postmodern perspectives in career development and counselling 051129cb56

The Oxford English Dictionary defines "career" as a person's "course or progress through life (or a distinct portion of life)". This definition relates "career" to a range of aspects of an individual's life, learning, and work. "Career" is also frequently understood to

relate to the working aspects of an individual's life - as in "career woman", for example. A third way in which the term "career" is used describes an occupation or a profession that usually involves specific training and/or formal education, considered to be a person's lifework. In this case "a career" is seen as a sequence of related jobs, usually pursued within a single industry or sector: one can speak for example of "a career in education", of "a criminal career" or of "a career in the building trade". A career has been defined by organizational behavior researchers as "an individual's work-related and other relevant experiences, both inside and outside of organizations, that form a unique pattern over the individual...

In 1935, Kurt Lewin, a German Gestalt psychologist, articulated that human behavior is a product of personal and environmental factors and formulated the equation $B=(P \times E)$. Urie Bronfenbrenner expanded Lewin's work in 1979 into Ecological Systems Theory. Ecological counseling... 051129cb56 Counseling psychology in

It currently includes many sub-disciplines, for example marriage and family counseling, rehabilitation counseling, clinical mental health counseling, educational counseling, etc. In each setting, they are all required to follow the same guidelines. 051129cb56 Rehabilitation counselors can be found in private practice, in rehabilitation facilities, hospitals, universities, schools, government agencies, insurance companies and other organizations where people are being treated for congenital or acquired disabilities. Over time, with the changes in social work being more psychotherapy-oriented, rehabilitation counselors take on more and more community engagement work, especially as it relates to special populations.
