Servicescape The aim of the servicescapes model is to explain behavior of people within the service environment with a view to designing environments that does not accomplish organisational goals in terms of achieving desired behavioural responses. enables the firm to “channel consumer realities in certain ways”. For consumers visiting a service or retail store, the service environment is the first aspect of the service that is perceived by the customer and it is at this stage that consumers are likely to form

Sense of place The term is used in. It is often used in relation to those characteristics that make a place special or unique, as well as to those that foster a sense of authentic human attachment and belonging. It is a characteristic that some geographic places have and some do not, while to others it is a feeling or perception held by people (not by the place itself). strip shopping malls, gas/petrol stations and convenience stores, fast food chains, and chain department stores have been cited as examples of placeless landscape The term sense of place refers to a multidimensional, complex construct used to characterize the relationship between people and spatial settings. Others, such as geographer Yi-Fu Tuan, have pointed to senses of place that are not "positive," such as fear.
