Hilbert's problems They were all unsolved at the time, and several proved to be very influential for 20th-century mathematics. Hilbert's problems are 23 problems in mathematics published by German mathematician David Hilbert in 1900. The complete list of 23 problems was published later, in English translation in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society. Hilbert presented ten of the problems (1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 19, 21, and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Congress of Mathematicians, speaking on August 8 at the Sorbonne. Earlier publications (in the original German) appeared in Archiv der Mathematik und Physik. Algebraic structures include groups, rings, fields, modules, vector spaces, lattices, and algebras over a field. The term abstract algebra was coined in the early 20th century to distinguish it from older parts of algebra, and more specifically from elementary algebra, the use of variables to represent numbers in computation and reasoning.
