The American Rental Association was founded as early as 1955, and the first waves of consolidation took place in the 1970s in North America, leading to the creation of companies with nationwide operations. Consolidation was

A typical Retainage is a portion of the agreed upon contract price deliberately withheld until the work is complete to assure that the contractor or subcontractor will satisfy its obligations and complete a construction project
