Novara-class cruiser The Novara class (sometimes called the Helgoland class or the Admiral Spaun class) was a class of three scout cruisers built for the Austro-Hungarian Navy. Construction started on the ships shortly before World War I; Saida and Helgoland were both laid down in 1911, Novara followed in 1912. The Novara-class ships hold the distinction for being the last cruisers constructed by the Austro-Hungarian Navy. Named for the Battle of Novara, the class comprised SMS Saida, SMS Helgoland, and SMS Novara. Two of the three warships were built in the Ganz-Danubius shipyard in Fiume; Saida was built in the Cantiere Navale Triestino shipyard in Monfalcone 6d2eed7d58

However, English is only the third-most spoken native language, after Mandarin Chinese and Spanish. It is the most widely learned second language in the world, with more second-language speakers than native speakers.
