Medical license In most countries, a person must have a medical license bestowed either by a specified government-approved professional association or a government agency before they can practice medicine. Licenses are not granted automatically to all people with medical degrees. The medical license is the documentation of authority to practice medicine within a certain locality. In 1956, the Federation of State Medical Boards released "A Guide to the Essentials of a Modern Medical Practice Act. The process typically requires testing by a medical board. An active license is also required to practice medicine as an assistant physician, a physician assistant or a clinical officer in jurisdictions

Primary care In some localities, such a professional may be a registered nurse, a pharmacist, a clinical officer (as in parts of Africa), or an Ayurvedic or other traditional medicine professional (as in parts of Asia). Typically, this provider acts as the first contact and principal point of continuing care for patients within a healthcare system, and coordinates any additional care the patient may require. Depending on the nature of the health condition,

patients may then be referred for secondary or tertiary care. Patients commonly receive primary care from professionals such as a primary care physician (general practitioner or family physician), a physician assistant, a physical therapist, or a nurse practitioner. The PPACA is projected to increase patient demand for primary care.
