Hagfish Hagfish are marine predators and scavengers that can defend themselves against other larger predators by releasing copious amounts of slime from mucous glands in their skin. until they find their way to the posterior end of the caudal region, whereby they find an opening in the digestive system. Hagfish are the only known living animals that have a skull but no vertebral column, although they do have rudimentary vertebrae. The hagfish embryo can develop Hagfish, of the class Myxini (also known as Hyperotreti) and order Myxiniiformes , are eel-shaped jawless fish (occasionally called slime eels)

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Gluten-free diet The inclusion of oats in a gluten-free diet remains controversial, and may depend on the oat cultivar and the frequent cross-contamination with other gluten-containing cereals. A gluten-free diet (GFD) is a nutritional plan that strictly excludes gluten, which is a mixture of prolamin proteins found in wheat (and all of its species and hybrids, such as spelt, kamut, and triticale), as well as barley, rye, and oats. people who do not have coeliac disease nor wheat allergy, with digestive or extra-digestive symptoms which improved removing wheat/gluten from the diet
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Artiodactyl The other three toes are either present, absent, vestigial, or pointing posteriorly. stomachs. Another difference between the two orders is that many artiodactyls (except for Suina) digest plant cellulose in one or more stomach chambers rather than in their intestine (as perissodactyls do). By contrast, most perissodactyls bear weight on an odd number of the five toes. The handicap of a heavy digestive system has increased selective pressure towards limbs that allow the animal to quickly escape predators. Molecular biology, along with new fossil

discoveries, has found that cetaceans (whales, dolphins, and porpoises. Most Artiodactyls are placental mammals belonging to the order Artiodactyla (AR-tee-oh-DAK-tih-lə; from Ancient Greek ἄρτιος ártios 'even' and δάκτυλος dáktulos 'finger, toe'). Typically, they are ungulates which bear weight equally on two (an even number) of their five toes (the third and fourth, often in the form of a hoof)
