Many Romance linguists consider it, together with Italian, as the language that is the closest to Latin among all of Latin's descendants. However, it has also incorporated elements of Pre-Latin (mostly Paleo-Sardinian and, to a much lesser degree, Punic) substratum, as well as a Byzantine Greek, Catalan, Spanish, French, and Italian superstratum. These elements originate in the political history of Sardinia, whose indigenous society experienced competition and, at times, conflict with a series of colonizing newcomers. f3695e184a

In the late 1920s there were nearly one hundred literary magazines. The number of consumer magazines was 975 in 1995 and 782 in 2004. From 1923 to 1943, the period of the Fascist Regime, only ten new Catholic magazines was started. A total of fifty-eight Catholic magazines was launched between 1867 and 1922. Following the end of World War II the number of weekly magazines significantly expanded.
