Case method In sharp contrast to many other teaching methods, the case method requires that instructors refrain from providing their own opinions about the decisions in question. It developed during the course of the twentieth-century from its origins in the casebook method of teaching law pioneered by Harvard legal scholar Christopher C. Langdell. Instructors who use the case method are asking students to devise, describe, and defend solutions to the problems presented by each case. Rather, the chief task of instructors who use the case method is asking students to devise, describe, and defend solutions to the problems presented by each case. The case method evolved. The case method is a teaching approach that uses decision-forcing cases to put students in the role of people who were faced with difficult decisions at some point in the past. Langdell 184aaa2e41
