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Nursing in Japan Presently, Japan recognizes four types of nurses: Public Health Nurses, Midwives, Registered Nurses and Assistant Nurses. By 1915, nurse registration had been established and public health nurses began working throughout the country. Initially introduced only in Tokyo in the late 1860s, small schools utilizing Western models were being opened by the late 1880s. Nursing universities were established in the twentieth century and regulations were passed to develop

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standards for training and public health. In response to disaster relief, the Japanese Red Cross became an integral part of nursing development. chemotherapy nursing, emergency care, hospice care, intensive care nursing, wound, ostomy, and continence nursing, and pain management nursing, after completion Nursing in Japan did not develop as an occupation until the end of the nineteenth century 2709bcdd05
