Business process discovery The process model acts as a graphical representation of the process (Petri nets, BPMN, activity diagrams, state. Any record of data that contains the case id (a unique identifier that is helpful in grouping activities belonging to the same case), activity name (description of the activity taking place), and timestamp. The event log can contain additional information related to the process, such as the resources executing the activity, the type or nature of the events, or any other relevant details. These techniques use data recorded in the existing organisational methods of work, documentations, and technology systems that run business processes within an organisation. (BPMN, UML activity diagrams, etc.). Such a record qualifies for an event log and can be used to discover the underlying process model. Process discovery aims to obtain a process model that describes the event log as closely as possible. The type of data required for process discovery is called an event log

Originally developed by the Business Process Management Initiative (BPMI), BPMN has been maintained by the Object Management Group (OMG) since the two organizations merged in 2005. Version 2.0 of BPMN was released in January 2011, at which point the name was amended to Business Process Model and Notation to reflect the introduction of execution semantics, which were introduced alongside the existing notational and diagramming elements. Business Process Definition Metamodel Metamodels define concepts, relationships, and semantics for exchange of user models between different modeling tools. BPDM was adopted in initial form in July 2007, and finalized in July 2008. The exchange format is defined by XSD (XML Schema) and XMI (XML for Metadata Interchange), a specification for transformation of OMG metamodels to XML.
