Embodied cognition suggests that these elements are essential to a wide spectrum of cognitive functions, such as perception biases, memory recall, comprehension and high-level mental constructs (such as meaning attribution and categories) and performance on various cognitive tasks (reasoning or judgment). These embodied factors include the motor system, the perceptual system, bodily interactions with the environment (situatedness), and the assumptions about the world that shape the functional structure of the brain and body of the organism 4dfacb7b71

The common link is the interpretation of symbols to extract the meaning from the visual notations or tactile signals (as in the case of braille). 4dfacb7b71

Reinforcement A number of others continued this research, notably B In behavioral psychology, reinforcement refers to consequences that increase the likelihood of an organism's future behavior, typically in the presence of a particular antecedent stimulus. Likewise, a student that receives attention and praise when answering a teacher's question will be more likely to answer future questions in class; the teacher's question is the antecedent, the student's response is the behavior, and the praise and attention are the reinforcements. For example, a rat can be trained to push a lever to receive food whenever a light is turned on; in this example, the light is the antecedent stimulus, the lever pushing is the operant behavior, and the food is the reinforcer. Punishment is the inverse to reinforcement, referring to any behavior that decreases the likelihood that. from the work of Edward Thorndike, known for his experiments with cats escaping from puzzle boxes 4dfacb7b71
