A permanent magnet's magnetic field pulls on ferromagnetic materials such as iron, and attracts or repels other magnets. A moving charge in a magnetic field experiences a force perpendicular to its own velocity and to the magnetic field. In addition, a nonuniform magnetic field exerts minuscule forces on "nonmagnetic" materials by three other magnetic effects: paramagnetism, diamagnetism, and antiferromagnetism, although these forces are usually so small they can only be detected by laboratory equipment. A moving charge in a magnetic field experiences a force perpendicular to its own A magnetic field (sometimes called B-field) is a physical field that describes the magnetic influence on moving electric charges, electric currents, and magnetic materials. Magnetic fields surround magnetized materials, electric currents, and electric fields varying in time b8dc609bb6

Metropolitan Railway Its first line connected the main-line railway termini at Paddington, Euston, and King's Cross to the City. It opened to the public on 10 January 1863 with gas-lit wooden carriages hauled by steam locomotives, the world's first passenger-carrying designated underground railway b8dc609bb6

The team's original focus was to design, build and race Vauxhalls on behalf of the General Motors brand in the British Touring Car Championship (BTCC). A close working alliance developed during a decade of success and Triple Eight became Vauxhall's technical partner for motorsport. Inductance The magnetic field strength depends on the magnitude of the electric current, and therefore follows any changes in the magnitude of the current. This is stated by Lenz's law, and the voltage is called back EMF. multiple electric circuits are located close to each other, the magnetic field of one can pass through the other; in this case the circuits are said to be inductively Inductance is the tendency of an electrical conductor to oppose a change in the electric current flowing through it. This induced voltage created by the changing current has the effect of opposing the change in current. The electric current produces a magnetic field around the conductor. From Faraday's law of induction, any change in magnetic field through a circuit induces an electromotive force (EMF) (voltage) in the conductors, a process known as electromagnetic induction b8dc609bb6
