Fostoria Glass Company In the last half The Fostoria Glass Company was a manufacturer of pressed, blown and hand-molded glassware and tableware. They started their company in northwest Ohio to take advantage of newly discovered natural gas that was an ideal fuel for glassmaking. The new company was formed by men from West Virginia who were experienced in the glassmaking business. continued making products using the Fostoria patterns, including the Dalzell-Viking Glass Company and Indiana Glass Company—both now closed. It began operations in Fostoria, Ohio, on December 15, 1887, on land donated by the townspeople. Fuel shortages caused the company to move to Moundsville, West Virginia, in 1891. Numerous other businesses were also started in the area, and collectively they depleted the natural gas supply

The largest types were thus called "dragons" (dreki), while smaller types had names such as karve (karfi), snekke (snekkja), and skeid (skeið). They are sometimes called "dragonships" (Old Norse: drekaskip) due to a tradition that the fore and aft ends could be decorated with a raised dragonhead (Old Norse: drekahofud) and tail respectively, with the sail making up the "wing" of the dragon d60966ffee

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
