Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work. centuries. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. Intentional alterations may have been made as well, for example, the censoring of printed work for political, religious or cultural. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant b354be00c6

The song likely rooted the word "Dixie" in the American vocabulary as a nickname for the Southern United States. It was not a folk song at its creation, but it has since entered the American folk vernacular.
