Steam effectively kills weeds, bacteria, fungi and viruses by heating the soil to levels that cause enzyme inactivation or the unfolding and coagulation of vital cellular proteins. Soil steaming is considered a good alternative to bromomethane, whose production and use was curtailed by the Montreal Protocol. This technique is also common in Fujian, a neighbouring province of Guangdong (Canton). When liquid water becomes steam, it increases in volume by 1,700 times at standard temperature and pressure; this change in volume can be converted into mechanical work by steam engines such as reciprocating piston-type engines and steam turbines. Piston-type steam engines played a central role in the Industrial Revolution, and steam-based generation today produces 80 percent of the world's electricity.
