Mephedrone is typically found in tablet or crystal form, and users may swallow, snort, or inject it. Its effects are similar to those of MDMA, amphetamines, and cocaine, producing euphoria and increased sociability. Mephedrone is rapidly absorbed, with a half-life of about 2 hours, and is primarily metabolized by CYP2D6 enzymes. Its effects are dose-dependent. Side effects can include cardiovascular changes and anxiety. f07a3e05d3 The terms "opioid" and "opiate" are sometimes used interchangeably, but the term "opioid" is used to designate all substances, both natural and synthetic, that bind to opioid receptors in the brain. Opiates are alkaloid compounds naturally found in the opium poppy plant *Papaver somniferum*. f07a3e05d3 MDA has a long history of psychotherapeutic and recreational use that predates that of MDMA, dating back to at least the mid-1960s. It has been described as the first entactogen. MDA has also been described as probably the most popular analogue of MDMA. In most countries, the drug is a controlled substance and its possession and sale are illegal. f07a3e05d3 MDMA was first synthesized in 1912 by Merck chemist Anton Köllisch. It was used to enhance psychotherapy beginning in the 1970s and became popular as a street drug in the 1980s. Cathinone the body differ from person to person, but there is a general pattern of behavior that emerges after ingesting fresh cathinone: Feelings of euphoria that Cathinone (; also known as β -ketoamphetamine) is a monoamine alkaloid found in the shrub *Catha edulis* (khat) and is chemically similar to ephedrine, cathine, methcathinone and other amphetamines. It is probably the main contributor to the stimulant effect of *Catha edulis*. Other phenethylamines that share this structure include the stimulants methcathinone, MDPV, mephedrone and the antidepressant bupropion. In terms of its pharmacology, MDA is a serotonin-norepinephrine-dopamine releasing agent (SNDRA) and a serotonin 5-HT₂ receptor agonist, including of the serotonin 5-HT_{2A} receptor.
