Timeline of mathematics pure and applied mathematics history. Ancient Egyptian mathematics These tables allowed the scribes to rewrite any Ancient Egyptian mathematics is the mathematics that was developed and used in Ancient Egypt c. From these texts it is known that ancient Egyptians understood concepts of geometry, such as determining the surface area and volume of three-dimensional shapes useful for architectural engineering, and algebra, such as the false position method and quadratic equations. Evidence for Egyptian mathematics is limited to a scarce amount of surviving sources written on papyrus. The ancient Egyptians utilized a numeral system for counting and solving written mathematical problems, often involving multiplication and fractions. other unit fractions. 3000 to c. Ancient and medieval Indian mathematical works, all composed in Sanskrit, usually consisted of a section of sutras in which a set Indian mathematics emerged in the Indian subcontinent from 1200 BCE until the end of the 18th century. History of mathematics Before the modern The history of mathematics deals with the origin of discoveries in mathematics and the mathematical methods and notation of the past. From 3000 BC the Mesopotamian states of Sumer, Akkad and Assyria, followed closely by Ancient Egypt and the Levantine state of Ebla began using arithmetic, algebra and geometry for taxation, commerce, trade, and in astronomy, to record time and formulate calendars. Before the modern age and worldwide spread of knowledge, written examples of new mathematical developments have come to light only in a few locales

Smirnov's principal works in mathematical statistics and probability theory were devoted to the investigation of limit distributions by means of the asymptotic behaviour of multiple integrals as the multiplicity is increased with limit. He was one of the creators of the nonparametric methods in mathematical statistics and of the theory of limit distributions of order statistics.
