The internationalization of deterrence—extending military capabilities to allies—has since become a key strategy for states seeking to project power while mitigating direct conflict, as seen in Cold War missile. of nuclear weapons and their internationalization through policies like nuclear sharing and nuclear umbrellas. It is related to but distinct from the concept of mutual assured destruction, according to which a full-scale nuclear attack on a power with second-strike capability would devastate both parties d704db80ec
