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Alexander Radó He was involved in communist regime in Hungary until it fell in 1919. Its name was changed to Geodézia és Kartográfia (Geodesy and Kartography) after Radó joined the editorial board. He attended school in Budapest, before being drafted into the Austro-Hungarian army in 1917, where he became a communist. from 1949. There is some uncertainty as to his movements at that point. One source states he moved to Germany in the autumn of 1919 to study geography and cartography, while another states he remained in Austria, where he established the ROSTO-Vienna news. In 1956, it was expanded with Alexander Radó (also Alexander Radolfi, Sándor Kálmán Reich, Alexander Rado; born Sándor Radó, Hungarian: [ˈʃaːndor ˈrɒdoː]; 5 November 1899 – 20 August 1981) was a Hungarian cartographer who later became a Soviet military intelligence-agent in World War II.
