Humbaba He is invariably portrayed as the inhabitant or guardian of the cedar forest, to which Gilgamesh ventures with his companion Enkidu. comparable to demons. He was portrayed as an anthropomorphic figure comparable to an ogre or giant. Humbaba is also attested in other works.
