The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oides ("resembling in form or appearance"). More generally, desalination is the removal of salts and minerals from a substance. This is important for agriculture. Modern interest in desalination mostly focuses on cost-effective provision of fresh water for human use. It is possible to desalinate saltwater, especially sea water, to produce water for human consumption or irrigation, producing brine as a by-product. One example is soil desalination. Humidity depends on the temperature and pressure of the system of interest. The same amount of water vapor results in higher relative humidity in cool air than warm air. A related parameter is the dew point. The amount of water vapor needed to achieve saturation increases as the temperature increases. As the temperature of a parcel of air decreases it will eventually reach the saturation point without adding or losing water mass. The amount of water vapor contained within a parcel of air can vary significantly. Nonmetal They range from colorless gases like hydrogen to shiny crystals like iodine. form negatively charged ions

with oxygen in aqueous solutions. Drawing on this, in 1864 the 'Manual of Metalloids' divided all elements into either metals. In the context of the periodic table, a nonmetal is a chemical element that mostly lacks distinctive metallic properties. Chemically, nonmetals have relatively high electronegativity or usually attract electrons in a chemical bond with another element, and their oxides tend to be acidic. Physically, they are usually lighter (less dense) than elements that form metals and are often poor conductors of heat and electricity.
