transcription service A transcription service is a business service that converts speech (either live or recorded) into a written or electronic text document. In addition, payment to dental professionals is based on the Current Dental Terminology (CDT) is a code set with descriptive terms developed and updated by the American Dental Association (ADA) for reporting dental services and procedures to dental benefits plans. In 2010 the ADA ended the CMS distribution of CDT codes, which can now be purchased from the ADA. Document management system The term has some overlap with the concepts of content management systems. Some systems include history tracking where a log of the various versions created and modified by different users is recorded. Test data However Test data are sets of inputs or information used to verify the correctness, performance, and reliability of software

systems. representative (real) data. Test data encompass various types, such as positive and negative scenarios, edge cases, and realistic user scenarios, and aims to exercise different aspects of the software to uncover bugs and validate its behavior. Due to privacy regulations such as GDPR, PCI, and the HIPAA, the use of privacy-sensitive personal data for testing is restricted. Test data is also used in regression testing to verify that new code changes or enhancements do not introduce unintended side effects or break existing functionalities aa81b3ad1e

Picture archiving and communication system Non-image data, such as scanned documents, may be incorporated using consumer industry standard formats like PDF (Portable Document Format), once encapsulated in DICOM. A PACS consists of four major components: The imaging modalities such as X-ray plain film (PF), computed tomography (CT). overlooked, part of the PACS Architecture (see below). Electronic images and reports are transmitted digitally via PACS; this eliminates the need to manually file, retrieve, or transport film jackets, the folders used to store and protect X-ray film. The universal format for PACS image storage and transfer is DICOM (Digital Imaging and Communications in Medicine). Patient check-in Then, on August 21, 1996, President Clinton signed HIPAA into law, which included a Privacy Rule designed to protect patient's privacy Patient check-in is the process where patients begin their registration with the healthcare facility typically using a clipboard, electronic tablet, touch screen, kiosk, or by other method, sometimes self-service. Patient check-in start as far back as the Roman times when patients would wait for special services in purpose-built hospitals.
