These non-directive interviews are considered to be the opposite of a structured interview which offers a set amount of standardized questions. They tend to be more informal and free flowing than a structured interview, much like an everyday conversation. This nature of conversation allows for spontaneity and for questions to develop during the course of the interview, which e7fcf4ad5c

This feature is common to many types of interviews – a job interview or interview with a witness to an event may have no other audience present at the time, but the answers will be later provided to others in the employment or investigative process. An interview may also transfer information in both directions.
