This involves the individually planned and systematically monitored arrangement of teaching procedures, adapted equipment and materials, and accessible settings. , SDC, and SPED) is the practice of educating students in a way that accommodates their individual differences, disabilities, and special needs. These interventions are designed to help individuals with special needs achieve a higher level of personal self-sufficiency and success in school and in their community, which may not be available if the student were only given access to a typical classroom education
