The Berlin Crisis of 1961 was the second attempt by Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev to change the status of Berlin by demanding the withdrawal of all armed forces from the city and stopping the mass exodus of East Germans fleeing to the West. After the failure of his first ultimatum in 1958, Khrushchev renewed his demands at the 1961 Vienna summit, this time challenging the newly inaugurated U.S. President John F. Kennedy.

Berlin Crisis of 1961 The crisis culminated in the city's de facto partition with the East German erection of the Berlin Wall. A diplomatic victory at the summit would not only enhance Khrushchev's prestige among Soviet hardliners but also boost his standing within the broader The Berlin Crisis of 1961 (German: Berlin-Krise) was the last major European political and military incident of the Cold War concerning the status of the German capital city, Berlin, and of post-World War II Germany
