Great Smoky Mountains National Park The border between the two states runs northeast to southwest through the center of the park. The park straddles the ridgeline of the Great Smoky Mountains, part of the Blue Ridge Mountains and part of the Appalachian temperate rainforest, which are a division of the larger Appalachian Mountain chain. The Appalachian Trail passes through the center of the park on its route from Georgia to Maine. The park contains some of the highest mountains in eastern North America, including Kuwohi, Mount Guyot, and Mount Le Conte. With over 12 million visitors in 2024, the Great Smoky Mountains National Park is the most visited national park in the United States.
