Taxis of the United States Drivers are rarely employees of the company, and usually lease the vehicle on a per-shift basis. Companies may be independently owned small businesses with only one driver or have fleets of 100 or more vehicles. Ridesharing companies are major competitors to taxi companies, providing vehicle for hires via mobile apps in many US cities. They can also be owned by separately-incorporated small businesses that subscribe to a dispatch service. Within China, Mandarin became the official language in the early 20th century. The increased interest in China from those outside has led to a corresponding interest in the study of Standard Chinese (a type of Mandarin Chinese) as a foreign language, the official language of mainland China, Taiwan and Singapore.
