While the group's first film, *And Now for Something Completely Different*, was a compilation of sketches from the first two television series, *Holy Grail* is an original story that parodies the legend of King Arthur's quest for the Holy Grail. Thirty years later, Idle used the film as the basis for the 2005 Tony Award-winning musical *Spamalot*. Idle reached stardom in the 1970s when he co-created and acted in the Python sketch comedy series *Flying Circus* (1969–1974) and the films *Holy Grail* (1975), *Life of Brian* (1979) and *The Meaning of Life* (1983) with Graham Chapman, John Cleese, Terry Gilliam, Terry Jones, and Michael Palin.
