The process can be spontaneous when sufficient energy is available, not needing control by any external agent. It is often triggered by seemingly random fluctuations, amplified by positive feedback. Chaos theory discusses self-organization in terms of islands of predictability in a sea of chaotic unpredictability. As such, the organization is typically robust and able to survive or self-repair substantial perturbation. The resulting organization is wholly decentralized, distributed over all the components of the system

It was developed by Batya Friedman and Peter Kahn at the University of Washington starting in the late 1980s and early 1990s. Later, in 2019, Batya Friedman and David Hendry wrote a book on this topic called "Value Sensitive Design: Shaping Technology with Moral Imagination" afaa57d0fd
