Roget's Thesaurus It began as a compilation for personal use, but was published in 1852. Roget's Thesaurus is a widely used English-language thesaurus, created from 1805 by Peter Mark Roget (1779–1869), a British physician, natural theologian

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On 8 April 1546 with the Council of Trent, the Catholic Church had approved the 4th century Vulgate of Jerome as its official Bible. Maria Pantelia, also a classics professor at UC Irvine, succeeded Theodore Brunner in 1998, and has been directing the TLG since. Historical Thesaurus of English From the 1980s onwards the project was moved from paper-based records to a computer database. The HTE was conceived and begun in 1965 by the English Language & Linguistics department of the University of Glasgow, who have ever since continued to compile the thesaurus. In this way, the HTE arranges the whole vocabulary of English, from the earliest written records in Old English to the present, alongside dates of use. 82215329fe The project was founded in 1894 by Eduard Wölfflin and the first fascicle was published in 1900. At the time, the researchers thought it would take up to 20 years to complete the thesaurus. Today, it is expected that the work will be completed around the year 2050. The last fascicle of the P-volume appeared in 2010, and as of 2025 the work is under way on N and R. The institution that carries out the work of the dictionary is located in Munich, in the Bavarian Academy of Sciences and Humanities. Wölfflin described the entries in the TLL as "biographies" rather than definitions. 82215329fe The book was unusual for its time, published in a period when cookbooks were occupied with questions of food origins and seasonality.
