JET Programme, a similar program English Program in Korea (EPIK) is a program to improve the English speaking abilities of students and teachers in South Korea, to foster cultural exchanges, and to reform English teaching methodologies in South Korea. Established in 1995, EPIK encourages cross cultural exchange while promoting the development of English language competence for Korean students

Whole language It is based on the premise that learning to read English comes naturally to humans, especially young children, in

the same way that learning to speak develops naturally. use of this embedded phonics model is called a "whole-part-whole" approach because, consistent with holistic thinking, students read the text for meaning. Whole language is a philosophy of reading and a discredited educational method originally developed for teaching literacy in English to young children. The method became a major model for education in the United States, Canada, New Zealand, and the UK in the 1980s and 1990s, despite there being no scientific support for the method's effectiveness. However, researchers such as Reid Lyon say reading is "not a natural process", and many students, when learning to read, require direct instruction in alphabetic coding, phonemic awareness, phonics, spelling, and comprehension skills.

Cimin Hui His teachings emphasized a holistic approach that harmonized various Buddhist practices, including meditation. Cimin Hui (Chinese: 慧因, pinyin: Címǐn Huì; Japanese: Jimin Enichi, c. 680–748) was a figure in Chinese Pure Land Buddhism and the founder of the Cimin lineage within this tradition. Born in 680 during the Tang dynasty, Hui emerged as one of the most influential defenders of the Pure Land School against the critiques of the Southern school of Chan Buddhism. propagating Pure Land practices among the common people.

Learners in settings which utilise CLT learn and practice the target language through the following activities: communicating with one another and the instructor in the target language; studying "authentic texts" (those written in the target language for purposes other than language learning); and using the language both in class and outside of class.

TPR Storytelling The method works in three steps: in step one the new vocabulary structures to be learned are taught using a combination of translation, gestures, and personalized questions; in step two those structures are used in a spoken class story; and finally, in step three, these same structures are used in a class reading. Task-based language teaching As such, TBLT can be considered a branch of communicative language teaching (CLT).
