Toyota Mark II Toyota replaced the rear-wheel-drive Cressida in North America with the front-wheel-drive Avalon. Prior to 1972, the model was marketed as the Toyota Corona Mark II. Every Mark II and Cressida was manufactured at the Motomachi plant at Toyota, Aichi, Japan from September 1968 to October 1993, and later at Toyota Motor Kyushu's Miyata plant from December 1992 to October 2000, with some models also assembled in Jakarta, Indonesia and Parañaque, Philippines as the Cressida.
