The ubiquitous television set became the display device for the first recorded media for consumer use in the 1970s, such as Betamax, VHS; these were later succeeded by DVD. As an example, the RCA CT-100 color TV set used 36 vacuum tubes. bulky, with analog circuits made of vacuum tubes. The addition of color to broadcast television after 1953 further increased the popularity of television sets in the 1960s, and an outdoor antenna became a common feature of suburban homes d371ca45d7

Pressure is typically measured in units of force per unit of surface area. Instruments used to measure and display pressure mechanically are called pressure gauges, vacuum gauges or compound gauges (vacuum & pressure).
