G factor (psychometrics) It is a variable that summarizes positive correlations among different cognitive tasks, reflecting the assertion that an individual's performance on one type of cognitive task tends to be comparable to that person's performance on other kinds of cognitive tasks. They attributed the somewhat lower correlations with the CFIT battery to its lack of content diversity The g factor is a construct developed in psychometric investigations of cognitive abilities and human intelligence. Cattell Culture Fair Intelligence Test (the CFIT). The terms IQ, general intelligence, general cognitive ability, general mental ability, and simply intelligence are often used interchangeably to refer to this.
