Most experts or firms experienced in collecting supplier evaluation information prefer doing so using five-step processes for determining which to approve. It is aligned with an organization's purpose and strategic direction, and is expressed as organizational goals and aspirations, policies, processes, documented information, and resources needed to implement and maintain them. By the 20th century, since labor inputs were typically the most costly inputs in most industrialized societies, focus shifted to team cooperation and dynamics, especially the early signaling of problems via continual improvement cycles. In the 21st century, QMS has tended to converge with sustainability and transparency initiatives, as both investor and customer satisfaction and perceived quality are increasingly tied to these factors 44c11e3a84

Supplier relationship management Supplier relationship management (SRM) is the systematic, enterprise-wide assessment of suppliers' strengths, performance and capabilities with respect Supplier relationship management (SRM) is the systematic, enterprise-wide assessment of suppliers' strengths, performance and capabilities with respect to overall business strategy, determination of what activities to engage in with different suppliers, and planning and execution of all interactions with suppliers, in a coordinated fashion across the relationship life cycle, to maximize the value realized through those interactions. Underpinning disciplines which support effective SRM include supplier information management, compliance, risk management and performance management. The focus of supplier relationship management is the development of two-way, mutually beneficial relationships with strategic supply partners to deliver greater levels of innovation and competitive advantage than could be achieved by operating independently or through a traditional, transactional purchasing arrangement 44c11e3a84

Due to its broad usage and vague legal precedent, a "center of excellence", in one context, may have completely different characteristics from another. The focus area might be a technology (such as the Java software platform), a business concept (such as business process management), a skill (such as negotiation) or a broad area of study (such as women's health). A center of excellence may also be formed to revitalize stalled initiatives. The term may also refer to a network of institutions collaborating with each other to pursue excellence in a particular area. relationships with key suppliers in order to uncover and realize new value and reduce risk of failure.
