In 2000, the NCTM revised its CESSM with the publication of *Principles and Standards for School Mathematics (PSSM)*. Like those in the first publication, the updated recommendations became the basis for many states' mathematics standards, and the method in textbooks developed by many federally-funded projects. critical terms refer to the 1989 Standards rather than the PSSM.
