Histogram To construct a histogram, the first step is to "bin" (or "bucket") the range of values— divide the entire range of values into a series of intervals—and then count how many values fall into each interval. The Freedman–Diaconis rule gives bin width h as: $h = 2 \text{ IQR} (x)$ A histogram is a visual representation of the distribution of quantitative data. The bins are usually specified as consecutive, non-overlapping intervals of a variable. proposed it suggests that this is also the origin of the Rice rule. The bins (intervals) are adjacent and are typically (but not required to be) of equal size
