Introduction to entropy energy necessary for ice melting per mole has been found to be $6008 \text{ J at } 273 \text{ K}$. For example, cream and coffee can be mixed together, but cannot be "unmixed"; a piece of wood can be burned, but cannot be "unburned". A more physical interpretation of thermodynamic entropy refers to spread of energy or matter, or to extent and diversity of microscopic motion. The word 'entropy' has entered popular usage to refer to a lack of order or predictability, or of a gradual decline into disorder. Therefore, the entropy change per mole is $q_{rev} / T = 6008 \text{ J } / 273 \text{ K}$. In thermodynamics, entropy is a numerical quantity that shows that many physical processes can go in only one direction in time.

Dihydrogen is colorless, odorless, non-toxic, and highly combustible. It is the lightest and most abundant chemical element in the universe, constituting about 75% of all normal matter. Stars, including the Sun, mainly consist of hydrogen in a plasma state, while on Earth, hydrogen is found as the gas H₂ (dihydrogen) and in molecular forms, such as in water and organic compounds. Cannabis and impaired driving Several recent, extensive studies—including one conducted by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and one conducted by the American Automobile Association (AAA)—show that drivers with detectable THC in their blood are no more likely to cause car crashes than drivers with no amount of THC in their blood. On the first question, studies are mixed. Others show that cannabis can impair certain abilities important to safe driving (such as reaction time, divided attention, and cognitive functions)—but.
