Landover is described as a small world, surrounded on all sides by fairy mists which connect it to many other worlds, including Earth. Landover is a rural kingdom, populated by humans, gnomes, kobolds, and various other fantasy creatures, all of whom speak the fictional language of "Landoverian" - which the protagonist can speak through magical means - and who often form separate societies. Their rulers, while answerable

to the king, are allowed a certain degree of autonomy. Also inhabiting the land are the characters of Strabo, a dragon, and the witch Nightshade. The story centers on a pair of stepsisters named Bawang Putih and Bawang Merah. Bawang Putih is the Malay and/or Indonesian word for garlic, while Bawang Merah is the Malay and/or Indonesian word for onion or shallot. This naming convention is in the same vein as the Western fairy tale sisters of Snow-White and Rose-Red, although the previous do not get along as well. The use of these names for the female protagonist and her antagonist is symbolic of their physical similarity (both girls are beautiful), but they have completely different personalities. Since the original folktale was passed on orally, different variations of the story exist. In most versions, Bawang Putih is the good and kind daughter, while Bawang Merah is the cruel and vindictive one, while in the 1959 black and white Malaysian movie, it is the other way around. List of songs recorded by Kelly Clarkson In 2004, Clarkson recorded the song "Breakaway", which was released as a single from the soundtrack of the film *The Princess Diaries 2: Royal Engagement*. The song's commercial success inspired Clarkson to name her second studio album *Breakaway*. Clarkson's third studio album, *My December*. "Christmas Eve", "I've Love You Since Forever", and "I Dream in Southern" were originally released as non-album singles and tracks American singer Kelly Clarkson has recorded material for her ten studio albums. "Miss Independent" was followed by "Low" and "The Trouble With Love Is", which was featured as a single from the soundtrack of the film *Love Actually*. The album won a Grammy Award for Best Pop Vocal Album in 2006, while its second single, "Since U Been Gone", won for Best Female Pop Vocal Performance. Its lead single, "Miss Independent", received a nomination for a Grammy Award for Best Female Pop Vocal Performance in 2004. Clarkson shifted genres to pop rock for *Breakaway* (2004), one of the best-selling albums of the 21st century. Its singles "Since U Been Gone" and "Behind These Hazel Eyes" were among the top ten charted songs of 2005 in the US, while "Because of You" topped the charts in Europe.
