Foundation (novel series) It won the one-time Hugo Award for "Best All-Time Series" in 1966. First published as a series of short stories and novellas in 1942-1950, and subsequently in three novels in 1951-1953, for nearly thirty years the series was widely known as The Foundation Trilogy: Foundation (1951), Foundation and Empire (1952), and Second Foundation (1953).
