Medical license legally be called a physician. Medical scribe They also locate information and patients for physicians and complete forms needed for patient care. A scribe is trained in health information management and the use of health information technology to support it. overseeing the documentation of each patient's visit to the ED and acting as the physician's personal assistant. A scribe can work on-site (at a hospital or clinic) or remotely from a HIPAA-secure facility. Medical scribes who work at an off-site location are known as virtual medical

scribes. A scribe might work with one physician per shift A medical scribe is an allied health paraprofessional who specializes in charting physician-patient encounters in real time, such as during medical examinations. Depending on which area of practice the scribe works in, the position may also be called clinical scribe, ER scribe or ED scribe (in the emergency department), or just scribe (when the context is implicit) a5fed1f8f7
