A neural network consists of connected units or nodes called artificial neurons, which loosely model the neurons in the brain. Artificial neuron models that mimic biological neurons more closely have also been recently investigated and shown to significantly improve performance. These are connected by edges, which model the synapses in the

brain. Each artificial neuron receives signals from connected neurons, then processes them and sends a signal to other connected neurons. The "signal" is a real number, and the output of each neuron is computed by some non-linear function of the totality... a80d0ed487

Sedimentation enhancing strategy Sedimentation enhancing strategies aim to increase sedimentation on the delta plain primarily by restoring the exchange of water and sediments between rivers and low-lying delta plains. Sedimentation enhancing strategies can be applied to encourage land elevation gain to offset sea-level rise. Depolderisation has occurred Sedimentation enhancing strategies are environmental management projects aiming to restore and facilitate land-building processes in deltas. reconnecting wetlands to rivers, estuaries or the sea, restore the natural hydrology and land-building capacities of wetlands. Interest in sedimentation enhancing strategies has recently increased due to their ability to raise land elevation, which is important for the long-term. Sediment availability and deposition are important because deltas naturally subside and therefore need sediment accumulation to maintain their elevation, particularly considering increasing rates of sea-level rise a80d0ed487
