Bhakti The concept includes a sense of deep affection Bhakti (Sanskrit: भक्ति; Pali: bhatti) is a concept common in Indian religions which means attachment, fondness for, devotion to, trust, homage, worship, piety, faith, or love. In Indian religions, it may refer to loving devotion for a personal God (like Krishna or Devi), a formless ultimate reality (like Nirguna Brahman or the Sikh God) or an enlightened being (like a Buddha, a bodhisattva, or a guru). such as "devotion, faith, devotional faith" represent certain aspects of bhakti, but it means much more. The deities of Hinduism have evolved from the Vedic era (2nd millennium BCE) through the medieval era (1st millennium CE), regionally within Nepal, Pakistan, India and in Southeast Asia, and across Hinduism's diverse traditions. The Hindu deity concept varies from a personal god as in Yoga school of Hindu philosophy, to thirty-three major deities in the Vedas, to hundreds of deities mentioned in the Puranas of Hinduism.... Tamil literature, in tandem with Sanskrit literature and the Sthala puranas of temples, form a major source of information regarding Tamil mythology. The ancient epics of Tamilakam detail the origin of various figures in Hindu scriptures, like Agathiyar, Iravan, and Patanjali. Ancient Tamil literature contains mentions of nature-based indigenous deities like Perumal, Murugan, and Kotravai. The Tolkappiyam hails Tirumal as Brahman, Murugan as Seyyon (the red one), and Kotravai as the goddess...

Ezili Dantor (though this has begun to shift in devotional art) and relatively wealthy, indicative of her status as an upper-class woman. The Ezili are feminine spirits in Haitian Vodou that personify womanhood. There are spelling variations of Erzulie, the other being Ezili. She has several manifestations or incarnations, but most prominent and well-known manifestations are Lasirenn (the mermaid), Erzulie Freda, and Erzulie Dantor. " It is said that Ezili Danto has a dark complexion and is maternal in nature. They are English interpretations of a Creole word, but do not differ in meaning. Thus, Ezili Dantor strongly resonates

Èzili Dantò or Erzulie Dantor is the main loa (or lwa) or senior spirit of the Petro family in Haitian Vodou. The Erzulie is a goddess, spirit, or loa of love in Haitian Voudou. Ezili Danto, or Èzili Dantò, is the "manifestation of Erzulie, the divinity of love a2e69c1c57

One of the earliest appearances of the concept is found in the early Buddhist Theragatha (Verses of the Elders) through the term bhakti. He was gifted with the boon of knowledge regarding the past, present, and the future. He appears in a number of Hindu texts, notably the Mahabharata, telling Yudhishtira the story of Prahalada, and he also appears in the Ramayana and the Puranas.
