Montessori education It emphasizes independence and it views children as naturally eager for knowledge and capable of initiating learning in a sufficiently supportive and well-prepared learning environment. Lessons are typically presented to small groups The Montessori method of education is a type of educational method that involves children's natural interests and activities rather than formal teaching methods. serve mixed-age 6- to 9-year-old and 9- to 12-year-old groupings; 6- to 12-year-old groups are also used. It also discourages some conventional methods of measuring achievement, such as grades and tests. A Montessori classroom places an emphasis on hands-on learning and developing real-world skills

Beginning in eighteenth-century historiography, many came to regard him as the first philosopher in the Greek tradition, breaking from the prior use of mythology to explain the world and instead using natural philosophy.
