Textual criticism Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant. is to provide a better understanding of the creation and historical transmission of the text and its variants. Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. This understanding may lead to the production Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. But he was also deeply rooted in the classical spirit of the Age of Enlightenment in his intellectual presuppositions, his use of philologic analysis, and his emphasis on both general and particular phenomena in history. Niebuhr was a leader of the Romantic era and symbol of German national spirit that emerged after the defeat at Jena.
