Where that annotation is a link (e.g. (hist)), it is a link to the page for the historical or mythical figure. The annotation "(fict)" is only used in entries for the English history plays, and indicates a character who is fictional. f645c6d661

The teller gives a name (such as "Noah"), a description (such as "Police"), or something that purports to be a name (such as "Needle").
