Although the concept of biology as a single coherent field arose in the 19th century, the biological sciences emerged from traditions of medicine and natural history reaching back to Ayurveda, ancient Egyptian medicine and the works of

It is the lightest and most abundant chemical element in the universe, constituting about 75% of all normal matter.
